## REGISTERING A TEAM

By the Deadline, a coach from each team will need to completely fill out and submit:

- Team Information Form (both sides) to the Office
- Team Conflict Sheet to the Scheduler
- Must have minimum # of players payed by the deadline (U8 & below – 3, U10 – 5, U12 – 6, U13+ – 7)

The team information form shows the birth year for each age group and the maximum number of players. No dual registrations are allowed. Teams that define themselves as recreational need to be aware of the definition of recreational teams as all waiting list players will be assigned to recreational teams if those teams do not already have full rosters.

Create only one profile per family and use that every time you log-in whether it be to register yourself as a coach or your children as players. This account will contain all your information and will also carry over from season to season, year to year. Any profile can log in to any of the club portals (necessary for families with players playing or coaches coaching in different clubs).

All coaches will register online (the background check is included with Stack Sports registration) and upload a photo and their CDC concussion certificate. Coaches must also access SafeSport through Stack Sports in order to get the course for free. Upon completion the certificate will also need to be uploaded. Coaches should also register with the Digital Coaching Center ([dcc.ussoccer.org](http://dcc.ussoccer.org)) for age appropriate licensing courses.

You will need to direct all players (via parent/guardian) to register online. All players will pay an individual fee for each season when they register. Proof of age (*government issued document i.e. passport or state birth certificate*) and player photos **MUST** be uploaded. THERE IS NO SECTION FOR A TEAM WHEN REGISTERING AN INDIVIDUAL! THE PLAYER WILL BE ASSIGNED TO A TEAM BY THE LEAGUE OR CLUB ADMINISTRATION.

The league will then assign those players that have registered in the Stack Sports system to your team.

BE SURE TO POINT OUT THAT ANY REGISTRATION ENTERED INTO THE WRONG CLUB WILL NEED TO BE REDONE IN THE CORRECT CLUB!

## REGISTERING AS A COACH

New Mexico Youth Soccer Association is using a registration platform called US Soccer Connect and Stack Sports. This platform requires coaches to register in the system. A Risk Management Disclosure / Authorization will be triggered automatically to NMYSA after registration is complete. Once registered, coaches can then access their account to upload their required SafeSport certificate, CDC Concussion Certificate and Photo (just head shot) at any time. The CDC online Concussion Certificate will be good for 4 years and Safe Sport certificates for 2 years. To register, you will access the US Soccer Connect system through the member league/club website with which you are coaching (see below). Be sure to select the correct club. If you are not sure what club you are in, it is likely the High Noon Soccer Club but you may want to ask...

Please access the SafeSport online course through your Stack Sports registration in order to take the course for free. If you do not access SafeSport through Stack Sports the course will cost \$20. **Please save a copy of the certificates** as you will be required to upload the certificate to your registration record on the new NMYSA registration platform.

***Please use any account previously created for this year's registration (Fall 2019). If you do, you will only have to correct or update any information instead of creating a whole new account.***

Be sure to complete the registration process spelled out below. If the "Confirm Registration" button is not hit, the player will NOT be able to be placed on a team...

- 1) Initial Parent/Guardian Info
- 2) In-Depth Parent/Guardian Info
- 3) In-Depth Player Info – Players must register in the age group of the player's birth year ONLY. Also make sure to have the insurance information on hand...
- 4) Uploads – A Photo and Government Issued Proof of Age MUST be uploaded...
- 5) Waivers
- 6) Payment
- 7) Confirmation

All families will use one log-in per family for both parents/guardians and all players. All players (via parent/guardian) will register online. Proof of age (*government issued document i.e. passport or state birth certificate*) and player photos **MUST** also be uploaded. Payment must also be made online. THERE IS NO SECTION FOR A TEAM WHEN REGISTERING AN INDIVIDUAL! THE PLAYER WILL BE ASSIGNED TO A TEAM BY THE LEAGUE OR CLUB ADMINISTRATION.

ANY REGISTRATION ENTERED INTO THE WRONG CLUB WILL NEED TO BE RE-DONE IN THE CORRECT CLUB!

***Note: All families will register under the same account.***

After successful completion of on-line materials, classroom materials, test, and field mentoring, the referee can officiate all USSF youth and amateur adult matches. The referee will not be assigned Las Cruces matches until they successfully complete an assigned mentoring-match in the LCYSL or MVSL. On-line materials must be completed before the formal classroom as much of the information will not be covered in class. On-line materials can take several hours to complete. Passing grade of the test is 75% and is taken at the end of the classroom instruction.
